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About National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT) Exam –March 2025 Batch-10

- ▶ The AICTE has framed a Scheme National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training (NITTT).
- ▶ The objective of the Scheme is to build a better educational ecosystem.
- ▶ It focuses on the capacity building of technical teachers, leading them to important facets of new teaching methodology and innovative means of knowledge transfer.



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About National Testing Agency

- ▶ National Testing Agency(NTA) is set up by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- ▶ It is set up as an independent, autonomous and self sustaining organisation.
- ▶ It is a Premier Testing Agency
- ▶ It conducts efficient, transparent and international standards tests in order to assess the competency of candidates for admission to premier higher educational institutions.
- ▶ **National Testing Agency (NTA)** has been entrusted with the responsibility to conduct the **Exam- March 2025 (Batch-10)**

- ▶ National Testing Agency will conduct NITTT Exam on **22, 23, 29 and 30 March 2025**
- ▶ The purpose of the webinar is to give an overview about the online exam to the candidates.



Admit Cards of March 2025 (Batch-10)

- ▶ Admit Cards are hosted on **NTA website**.
- ▶ Candidates can download and print their admit cards at <https://nitt.nta.ac.in/> using their Registration Number and Date of Birth.

Admit Card contains the following details, amongst others:

- ▶ Date and time course wise of exam
- ▶ Log in Time
- ▶ Log in ID
- ▶ Password
- ▶ Instruction and Advisory for candidates
- ▶ Specifications of the Desktop/PCs
- ▶ Specific **Do's and Don'ts**

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Mode of Exam- March 2025 (Batch-10)

- ▶ Candidates will be required to appear in the Exam on Laptop/Desktops/PCs only.
- ▶ They are not required to visit any exam centre for taking the exam.
- ▶ They will **not** be able to appear in the exam on **Mobile Phones**.
- ▶ They will have to make their own arrangements for Laptop/Desktops/PCs
- ▶ They should ensure that the Laptop is fully charged and has **stable internet connectivity** during the exam.
- ▶ Candidates may download SEB from <https://nittt.nta.ac.in/> for taking the Mock Test and Actual Exam, from 18 March 2025 onwards



Exam Format of NITTT Exam- March 2025 (Batch-10)

- ▶ Duration of the exam is **180 minutes**.
- ▶ The paper comprises 100 MCQs. Each question will have 4 options. Candidates will be required to mark any one of the options, which is the most appropriate answer, as their response. **Total Marks are 100**
- ▶ The test is delivered in **English** Only.
- ▶ There is **no negative marking**.
- ▶ A candidate is required to login **atleast 30 minutes** before his/her exam starts.
- ▶ He/she can not log in after the commencement of the exam.
- ▶ He/she can submit and leave the exam **60 minutes after commencement of Exam**
- ▶ SUBMIT button will be activated only 60 minutes after commencement of Exam



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Mock Test for NITTT Exam- March 2025 (Batch-10)

- ▶ Mock Test will be held during **19 March 2025** in the online mode.
- ▶ Candidates must take the mock test on Desktop/Laptop/PCs
- ▶ Mock test window will be open from **10.00 am to 06.00 pm on 19 March 2025**
- ▶ Candidates are required to **download the Secured Exam Browser** from the site <https://nittt.nta.ac.in> which will be made available on **18 March 2025**
- ▶ Candidates can log in using the Log in ID and Password indicated on the Admit Card.
- ▶ Candidates must appear in the Mock Test on **19 March 2025** without fail.
- ▶ Mock Test will be in English for all candidates.
- ▶ Duration of Mock Test is 180 **minutes. 50 questions. Candidates can submit the Test after 60 Minutes**

Specific Do's and Don'ts for the candidates of NITTT Exam- March 2025 (Batch-10)

1. Candidates should not move from their seats, during the exam. Candidates **cannot take bio breaks** during the duration of the exam.
2. Candidate should sit facing the screen throughout the exam and should not look sideways or down.
3. Candidates are **not allowed** to keep **cell phones, digital watches, or any other electronic devices** with them during the exam.
4. Candidates are **not** permitted to **wear sunglasses/headphones**.
5. Candidates should take the exam, seated in a room where there is sufficient light. Candidates **should** ensure that she/he is the only person in the room during the exam and there is no disturbance. Do not entertain any other person in the room
6. Candidates **should not contact/talk to anyone** or take the assistance from anyone during the exam.
7. Candidates should not keep any text or bits of paper or any material/notes/rough paper with you during the exam.
8. Candidates should not access any other site/screen on their laptop/Personal computers during the exam.
9. Candidates should not try to log in from multiple devices.
10. Candidates **should not google or search from any other source**.
11. Candidates should not lip-sync or read the questions aloud.
12. Candidates should not cover their face with hair/mask/clothing or anything else
13. Candidates should not have any background noise/voices/music/TV.
14. Candidates are not allowed to have food/beverage during the exam except water.
15. Candidates **should not** use F5 or toggle between applications.

Violation of any of the instructions mentioned above will be treated as Unfair Means and may result in disqualification/cancellation of the candidature.

Candidates are required to strictly adhere to the instructions, rules and regulations. No candidate should adopt any unfair means or indulge in any unfair practice.

Candidates are advised to go through the Admit Card hosted on the NTA website <http://nittt.nta.ac.in/>, carefully, before the webinar, Mock Test, and Exam.



Remote Proctoring

- The Exam is **remote Proctored**. Candidates are advised to note that they will be under invigilation by Human Proctors during the exam, who will monitor their movements, including those on their screen.
- At any point of time during the exam, if the Proctor finds any suspicious eye movements or any suspicious activities in the exam environment, candidate can be asked by the Proctor through Chat, to turn the Laptop/Webcam to show his/her surroundings to maintain the sanctity of the examination. Warning on Chat shall appear on the candidate's console on suspicious behavior. If the candidate does not follow the instructions even after repeated warnings from the Proctor, the exam can be terminated by the Proctor.
Candidates are to keep a check on the chat window for any communication from the Proctor.
- Candidates are expected to maintain the sanctity and integrity of the exam and **not resort to any unfair means.**
